

Blade Replacement for your Safety Razor

To change the blade of a MERKUR razor with a twist knob, please follow this guide. These steps are specifically designed for our two-piece razors.

- Preparation: Ensure your hands and the razor are completely dry to avoid any slipping. It's best to work in a dry environment and have a clean, dry towel nearby to wipe your hands if needed.
- 2. Loosen the razor cap: Hold the handle of the razor firmly and turn the twist knob at the bottom of the handle counterclockwise. This will loosen the cap that holds the blade. Continue turning until the cap is completely loose and can be removed.
- Remove the old blade: Carefully lift off the cap.
 The old blade is now exposed and can be safely removed. Grasp the blade by the non-sharpened edges to avoid cuts.
- 4. Insert a new blade: Take a new razor blade from its packaging and place it on the blade holder in the cap. Make sure the blade is properly aligned and that the holes or slots in the blade match the retaining pins in the cap.
- 5. Tighten the cap: Hold the handle of the razor firmly and turn the twist knob at the bottom of the handle clockwise until the cap is securely fastened to the razor. Be careful not to overtighten to avoid damaging the mechanism.



These steps ensure a safe and efficient blade change for your MERKUR razor. Always follow the safety instructions and handle razor blades with care.
